

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A WEBSITE

PROPOSAL SUBMISSION:

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

[The Organisation] is interested in receiving proposals to create a website with approximately [insert number] pages to be stored on a NZ-hosted server. [The Organisation] will provide all content as Microsoft Word files and all graphics as .JPG or .PNG or equivalent as required.

The finished product should accomplish the following:

- Provide the NZ Public, [The Organisation] Members and stakeholder with information about the services [The Organisation] provides.
- Have a consistent look and feel to all pages (fonts, graphics and color schemes).
- Load rapidly and provide easy navigation between pages.
- Contain links to other related websites.
- Be registered with the major search engines to ensure the website is listed
- Be Search Engine Optimized (SEO) so the website can be found when Internet users search for the website using keyword phrases.
- Have the ability to add ecommerce and email newsletter capabilities in the future.
- Use a Content Management System (CMS) capable of being maintained and updated by [The Organisation] personnel.
- Allow [The Organisation] personnel to upload images and place into website pages if needed.
- Allow [The Organisation] personnel to easily create and add new website pages if needed.



WEBSITE DESIGN:

The website should have a modern, contemporary design that utilises the existing [The Organisation] logo and colour scheme so as to be compatible with the marketing materials currently being used.

The new website should use several main navigation links or graphics, with drop-down lists of sub-pages so the user can easily navigate to any website page within the website.



SPECIAL FEATURES:

The website should have a **Contact Us** form page with approximately 15 form fields and/or drop-down lists so visitors can send comments, questions and other information to several departments.

Form information should be captured into a database and should be sent via email to the [insert location].



WEBSITE SEARCH:

There should be a **Search Box** so that visitors can enter keywords and phrases, and see a results page with links to pages within the website that matches the keywords entered in the search box.

HOSTING:

TECHNOLOGY:

PROPOSAL PREPARATION:

Firms and individuals submitting proposals shall be responsible for any and all costs and/or expenses associated with preparing such proposals. Proposals will be evaluated based on previous experience creating similar websites, quality of previous work, time to completion and price.



PROPOSAL EVALUATION:

Proposals should include a list of similar websites created in the last three years with the web address and a contact person and a project timeline. Proposals should also indicate any software products to be used in creating the [The Organisation] website.
